Sir,

I am directed to communicate that presently, the movement of timber and timber products are being regulated as per order dated 12/05/2001 of Hon'ble Supreme Court. The details of the existing procedure and proposed change suggested by the State in connection with above-mentioned reference are given below:-

Existing procedure: For transport of timber in any form within the North-eastern State is permitted. Similarly, such timber within the North-eastern State may be transported by any means of transport on the strength of transit pass/re-transit pass. Further, movement of timber and timber products including sawn timber, veneer, plywood etc from NE State shall be permitted to transport only by rail from the designated railway station and if sourced from the HPC cleared sawmill.

Proposed change:-Movement of timber outside the NE State should be allowed by road as well as railway without any regulations by the SIT (constituted pursuant to Hon'ble Supreme Court's order dated 13.1.2000 in W.P. (C) No.202/95). The existing system for movement of timber within the NE State may continue.

Existing procedure: Allotment of railway wagons for transportation of sawn timber and moulding beats/frames outside the State are being regulated by the SIT, New Delhi. At present 25 wagons are allotted in each of the quarter permitted to be loaded from Dharmanagar railway station.

Proposed change: SIT, New Delhi may be requested to consider Agartala Railway station and Udaipur Railway station as designated loading station in addition to existing loading station at Dharmanagar railway station. Considering the availability of timber the allotment of wagon may be increased from 25 to 40 in each quarter.

2. I am further directed to request you to please take the needful action for modification of existing procedure in the light of proposed change for easy movement of timber from the State.

The Governor, Tripura is pleased to amend the Para 4.1.a of the "Guidelines for extraction of trees from non-forest areas" notified vide No.F.7(200)/For/FP/2000-09/Part-II/19611-29 dated 20th October,2010 as mentioned below:

The Para 4.1.a shall be substituted by the following:

4. TREES NOT REQUIRING TREE REGISTRATION CERTIFICATES, EXTRACTION PERMISSION

- 4.1 No permission from Forest Department will be needed for extraction of trees from non-forest land in the following cases.
- a) For tree species namely Aam (Mangifera indica), Lichi (Litchi chinensis), Sajna (Moringa oleifera), Guava (Psidium guajava) and Rubber. The owner will, however, be required to intimate the local Range Officer at least 10 days in advance in Form prescribed by Forest Department about such intention.
 - 4.2 The State Govt, shall be competent to add or delete species in Para 4.1 above.

This is in part modification of No.F.7(200)/For/FP/2000-09/Part-II/19611-29 dated 20th October,2010. This will have immediate effect.

NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 41,42 and 76 of the Indian Forest Act, 1927 and read with the Gazette Notification No.5 dated 08/01/2018 on Indian Forest (Amendment) Act, 2017 issued by Ministry of Law & Justice, the State Government makes the following rules further to amend the Tripura Forest Transit Rules 1952 (here-in-after referred to as the Principal Rules), namely:

1. Short title and commencement:

- (i) These Rules may be called "The Tripura Forest Transit (5th Amendment) Rules, 2019",
- (ii) They shall come into force from the date of its publication in the Tripura Gazette.

2. Amendment of Sub-Rule (1) of Rule 1:

In sub-rule (1) of Rule 1 of the Principal Rules, after the expression except under paragraph 12", the expression "and Rule 12 A" shall be inserted.

3. After rule 12 of the Principal Rules, the following new rule shall be inserted-

"12A. Transport of Bamboos and Bamboo Products:

- (i) In respect of bamboos grown in private forests and plots, the owner may remove the same only on obtaining a Bamboo Pass in Form F1 (yellow colour), appended to these Rules, issued by the Beat Officer, on an application (in a prescribed format) made to him by such owner.
- (ii) In respect of bamboos grown in any land, other than private forests or plots, the Beat Officer or the Member Secretary of the Joint Forest Management Committee (JFMC) may issue the Bamboo Pass in Form F2 (green colour) appended to these Rules, on receipt of payment of charges due to the JFMC, Biodiversity Management Committee (BMC) and Tripura Biodiversity Board:

- (iii) For exporting green bamboos outside the State of Tripura, Bamboo Pass may issued by the Sub-Divisional Forest Officer, in Form F3 (blue colour) appended to these Rules, on an application made to the Sub-Divisional Forest Officer and such pass shall be considered as the national permit."
- (iv) No restrictions on movement of finished bamboo products or value added bamboo products No.G.P../T.P. shall be enforced.
- 4. This will be effective from the date of its issue.
